2017 Application Information for International Students

(Senior Visiting Student Program)

Program Introduction

An overseas student wishing to conduct research in a specific subject supervised by NUC professors may be admitted as a Senior Visiting Student. The program is normally one academic year long and two years in accumulation at most. Upon completion of the program, students will receive a program certificate.

Application Prerequisites

Applicant must be a non-Chinese citizen, above the age of 18 and under the age of 50, in good health, and have attained at least a Master's degree or have the title of Associate Professor or higher.

Language Proficiency Requirement

Certain level of Chinese or English is required.

Application Information

1. Application Materials

- 1.1 Application Form for International Students to Study at NUC (General Visiting Student Program)
- 1.2 Scanned copy of valid passport
- 1.3 Digital photo
- 1.4 Scanned copies of highest degree, or certification of academic title
- 1.5 Two recommendation letters from professors/associate professors or persons with relevant academic titles, and a research proposal
- 1.6 CV

1.7 Medical Certificate

1.8 Financial Statement --- a deposit of USD 2,500 under applicant's name in the bank, a bank slip, certificate of deposit issued by the bank

1.9 Certificate of Chinese proficiency level (if appropriate)

***Note:** Application documents should be original in English or Chinese, otherwise certified copies of English or Chinese translation should be attached. Please send application materials to study@nuc.edu.cn during the application period. Application with incomplete materials will not be considered.*

2. Application Fee

500RMB of application fee should be paid in cash, by UnionPay bank card or through online payment. Any other currency or travel check would not be accepted. The application fee is not refundable. Application without application fee will not be considered.

3. Application Period

Fall Semester Admission: from Mar. 1st to Apr. 30th

Spring Semester Admission: from Oct. 1st to Nov. 30th

4. Admission

Admission will be determined according to applicant's educational background and academic achievements. Letter of Admission and Visa Application for Study in China (Form JW201/202) will be issued:

Fall Semester Admission: in June

Spring Semester Admission: in January

5. Registration Period

Fall Semester: in early September (specified in the Admission Notification)

Spring Semester: in late February (specified in the Admission Notification)

6. Academic Semesters

Fall Semester: normally from September to next January (referring to school calendar);

Spring Semester: normally from February to June (referring to school calendar).

7. Tuition Fee

15,000RMB/academic year

Medical Insurance

The Ministry of Education of China requires that all international students must be medically insured throughout their entire planned period of study. Students who study at NUC for more than 6 months are required to purchase the Comprehensive Insurance Plan of Foreign Students on the day of registration. Students who study at NUC for less than 6 months could choose to buy overseas medical insurance, which must cover China, and submit relevant insurance proof on the day of registration. Students without valid medical insurance will not be allowed to register.

Visa Information

Student admitted to NUC may apply for visa at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate in his/her country with the Letter of Admission and the Visa Application for Study in China (Form JW201/JW202). Student applies for X1 Visa for study in China for over 6 months, or X2 visa for study in China for less than 6 months. Student with X1 Visa must come to the College of International Education and apply for Residence Permit within 30 days after arriving in China.
