(General Visiting Student Program)

Program Introduction

An overseas student wishing to study at NUC for undergraduate courses for one academic semester/year but not for a degree may be admitted as a General Visiting Student. The program is normally one academic semester long and two academic semesters in accumulation at most. Upon completion of the program, students will receive a program certificate and an official transcript.

Application Prerequisites

Applicant must be a non-Chinese citizen, above the age of 18 and under the age of 45, in good health, and has completed at least one year of undergraduate study at his/her own university

Language Proficiency Requirement

Chinese proficiency of HSK 5 (Total Score 180 or more) is required for applicants planning to take academic courses given in Chinese.

English proficiency of IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL (IBT) 78 is required for applicants planning to take academic courses given in English.

materials will not be considered.

2. Application Fee

500RMB of application fee should be paid in cash, by UnionPay bank card or through online

payment. Any other currency or travel check would not be accepted. The application fee is not

refundable. Application without application fee will not be considered.

3. Application Period

Fall Semester Admission: from Mar. 1st to Apr. 30th

Spring Semester Admission: from Oct. 1st to Nov. 30th

4. Admission

Admission will be determined according to applicant's educational background and academic

achievements. Letter of Admission and Visa Application for Study in China (Form

JW201/202) will be issued:

Fall Semester Admission: in June

Spring Semester Admission: in January

5. Registration Period

Fall Semester: in early September (specified in the Admission Notification)

Spring Semester: in late February (specified in the Admission Notification)

6. Academic Semesters

Fall Semester: normally from September to next January (referring to school calendar);

Spring Semester: normally from February to June (referring to school calendar).

7. Tuition Fee

8,000RMB/semester or 15,000RMB/academic year

Medical Insurance

The Ministry of Education of China requires that all international students must be medically

insured throughout their entire planned period of study. Students who study at NUC for more

than 6 months are required to purchase the Comprehensive Insurance Plan of Foreign

Students on the day of registration. Students who study at NUC for less than 6 months could

choose to buy overseas medical insurance, which must cover China, and submit relevant

insurance proof on the day of registration. Students without valid medical insurance will not

be allowed to register.

Visa Information

Student admitted to NUC may apply for visa at the Chinese Embassy/Consulate in his/her

country with the Letter of Admission and the Visa Application for Study in China (Form

JW201/JW202). Student applies for X1 Visa for study in China for over 6 months, or X2 visa

for study in China for less than 6 months. Student with X1 Visa must come to the College of

International Education and apply for Residence Permit within 30 days after arriving in

China.
