2017 Application Information for International Students

(PhD Program)

Introduction

The program is normally 3 years' full-time study and 8 years in accumulation at most. Upon successfully completing all the courses stipulated in the teaching plan and passing exams, students will receive a graduation certificate. Those who meet the requirements of Doctoral Degree will be conferred a Doctoral Degree.

Application Prerequisites

Applicant must be a non-Chinese citizen with a valid passport and the bachelor degree, above the age of 18 and under the age of 45, and in good health.

Language Proficiency Requirement

Chinese proficiency of HSK 5 (Total Score 180 or more) is required for applicants planning to take academic courses given in Chinese. English proficiency of IELTS 6.0 or TOEFL (IBT) 78 is required for applicants planning to take academic courses given in English, or exempt by agreement of the supervisor. Applicants without taking any language proficiency test or reaching the required level have to finish the one year's Foundation Program before entering the undergraduate study.

10. Certificate of language proficiency level (if appropriate)

11. Published papers with abstracts or other materials to support the applicant's research capabilities (if appropriate)

Note: Application documents should be original in English or Chinese, otherwise certified copies of English or Chinese translation should be attached. Please send application materials to study@nuc.edu.cn during the application period. Application with incomplete materials will not be considered.

2. Application Fee

800RMB of application fee should be paid in cash, by bank card or through online payment. Any other currency or travel check would not be accepted. The application fee is not refundable. Application without application fee will not be considered.

3. Application Period

Dec. 1st to next Apr. 30th

4. Admission

Admission will be determined according to applicant's educational background and academic achievements. Upon acceptance, Letter of Admission and Visa Application for Study in China (Form JW201/202) will be issued in June.

5. Registration Period

Early September (specified in the Admission Notification)

6. Academic Semesters

Fall Semester: normally from September to next January (referring to school calendar);

Spring Semester: normally from February to June (referring to school calendar).

7. Tuition Fee

24,000RMB/academic year

Medical Insurance

The Ministry of Education of China requires that all international students must be medically insured throughout their entire planned period of study. Students who study at NUC for more than 6 months are required to purchase the Comprehensive Insurance Plan of Foreign Students on the day of registration. Student applies for X1 Visa for study in China for over 6 months, and must come to the College of International Education and apply for Residence Permit within 30 days after arriving in China.
